The Department of Public Works would like to thank our residents for your cooperation during the last two months. Because of this, we were able to work more safely. We are now able to resume services as follows:

Metal and Consumer Electronic Devices (CEDs): Thursday pickups will resume on June 11. Please call 732-416-1829 to schedule a pickup. These items will continue to be accepted at the recycling drop-off center on Third Street. Please remember that **CEDs** include **computers** (desktop and laptop), **monitors**, **desktop printers**, **fax machines**, and **televisions only**. Items such as scanners, modems, cables, and keyboards should be included in household trash and **will not** be accepted at the recycling center.

Bulk Trash: Alternate Monday pickups will resume on June 22. As a reminder, bulk includes such items as furniture, windows, and other large debris, **and should be placed at curbside no sooner than the night before collection**. Lumber must be cut and tied, and all nails removed or bent over. To schedule a pickup, please call 732-416-1829.

Once the pickups resume, the dumpsters will be removed from the Borough yard at Third Street.
