- Spring Sports Discussion
 - o Progress, but summer might be better timing
 - Push the date past the start date to make sure we can safely restart (maybe fall)
 - No REC department nearby is doing traditional spring events
 - o Discuss doing alternative events like drive-in movies.
 - Diane will know the budget by March/April for June/July
 - Looking into buying our own movie equipment versus renting it
 - o Don't know if there will be any school facilities open for camps in the summer
- Soccer Program (Andrew)
 - The first discussion with the Soccer Club went well
 - Discussed that the REC committee and Soccer Club should sit down together
 - Need both groups to be on the same page before moving forward
 - Rec can't take over until they dissolve
 - Not taking over travel soccer, just rec to start
 - It's not going to be an easy lift off until 2022
 - Andrew will arrange a meeting with Angela before the next meeting to discuss when the Soccer club is shutting down
 - Who are the new coordinators was discussed
 - o Its too much for one or two people, need a whole team
 - John says that there is a lot to it and needs to be more than one person because there are a lot of factors needed to be handled
 - Fields need to be lined, goals put up/down, flags, etc.
 - Donna asks if it will be comparable to flag football
 - Registration cost is a lot in surrounding towns, considering lower it
 - Need a group together
 - Rich, Melissa, Dan, Glen (registration) Angela (maybe) are willing to help
 - o Goal: start basic and build
 - Need to be promoted
 - We can get around 70/80 kids to start
 - will get kids between school/friends hearing about it and wanting to play
 - It is a loss to the community without the Soccer club
 - Marvinny and Reid may be willing to help run camps and such

- Diane got a letter from the 8th grade advisor
 - Asking for the 8th grade scholarship
 - Sent by Cara Nacimento on March 2, 2021
 - 2- \$50 scholarships for 1 male / 1 female
 - Steve motioned, Donna seconded it, all in favor.
- Rich states he was approached by Vizzi and Delversano about basketball summer camp
 - We don't know what facilities
 - Possibly use a park for a week
 - It would happen the later half of June
 - The money goes to the coaches and district
 - Need to check with Borough Risk Manager
 - Steve says why not
 - Cindy asks about the covid protocol with it
 - Discuss that we need the parents to sign off/ waivers, so to cover the Rec Dept

 - o Cindy asks about an alternative possibly with the budget
 - We will do something
 - However budget is unknown
- Andrew makes the decision to step down after the Easter events
 - Needs to be able to spend more time with his family, explore new things, and take a break
 - He is pleased with all the REC has done
 - He will also be stepping away from the PTA
 - He is looking forward to the drive-in movie nights
 - Will be there to play music on 3/20
 - Stepping aside from the soccer program, need new people to step up
 - Sal will take it on with Angela
 - The REC Department will be losing Steve and Andrew by April
 - New nomination for the vice chair needed.
- Marylin brings a new Multicultural Celebration project and asks the Rec Department for support
 - Rich asks her to email the board
 - She will email the board and offers to help stuff eggs
 - She asks Melissa to add in the Rec Newsletter something about Diversity
 - She wants her project to include the Rec Department
 - She has Borough Hall, and 10 leading participants
 - The 10 participants bring their own 2 dishes from their cultures Sample sizes
 - Community will come together and learn
 - Projected date is Saturday, July 17, 2021 at the Knights of Columbus from 3-6pm Celebration to take place annually
 - Maybe use RSVP
 - Rec will partner with her by helping with management, advertising, flyers, and will attend
 - 10 cultures represented will set up their own station
 - You will walk around the room and learn about new cultures
 - Donna mentioned that East Brunswick does this event
